
Sean suggests.....



LIGHT

Trumer – Pils 4.9% abv

My favorite pils. Extremely crisp without a drying finish or metallic tang you can get from other (even well made) pilsners. Even some fruit notes to my palate.



MEDIUM

Ayinger – Celebrator 6.7% abv

This is the dopplebock that you measure all the rest against. Very smooth. A nice combination of maltiness and sweetness. Super easy to drink.



DARK

Oskar Blues – Gubna 9.5% abv

An Imperial IPA made with 1 hop. That is not standard operating procedure. Summit is the hop, so this will have some nice citrus tones to it. And at around 100 IBU's, it will bring the bitterness.
