LIGHT

Samuel Smith Old Brewery Pale Ale 5.0% abv

A balance of malt and hops, copper-coloured, with a full, rounded flavour and aftertaste that you expect from a British pale/ESB straight from the Tadcaster based brewery.



MEDIUM

Knee Deep Simtra 10.1% abv

Triple IPA brewed with Citra and Simcoe hops. From Lincoln, California. Reminiscent of Lagunitas Sucks which I recommended last month. Sense a pattern? Tastes lighter (much lighter than the abv suggests.)



DARK

Eagle Rock Brewing Threes 9.5% abv

“Comforting aromas of toasted bread and jasmine complement the peachy esters, toasted marshmallows and alcohol warmth on the palate. A substantial hop presence and dry finish balance out this delicious full-bodied strong rye ale. Cheers to an amazing 3 years!”
